

FATAL ACCIDENTS — AUSTRALIANS INVOLVED

ISTANBUL, Monday (AAP). — Three Australians died when a bus carrying tourists from London to Karachi was involved in a head-on crash with a truck on Saturday night near Yozgat in eastern Turkey, according to the semi-official Anatolia News Agency.

Anatolia named the dead Australians as Mr Geoffrey Charles Perry, 23, Mr Timothy Craig [Snelling], 24, and Mr David Attwater, 24. The agency did not carry any addresses.

Eleven people died in the smash.

DRIVER OF BUS HELD

ANKARA, Turkey, Tuesday (AAP-Reuter). — The Pakistani driver of a tourist bus in which three Australians and eight others were killed in Central Turkey on Sunday has been arrested, it was learnt yesterday.

The Pakistani, Mr Hassan Khan, 27, was detained on suspicion of having driven while under the influence of drink, and of trafficking in drugs.

Earlier reports said the bus driver had been killed.

The Australian Embassy in Ankara named yesterday the Australians who died as Mr Timothy Craig Snefflinch [Snelling], Mr Geoffrey Giles Perry, and Mr David Attwater.
